## Public Rights of Way (PROW)

There are a number of PROW's in the parish and these are well used, even more so during the current pandemic. The Parish Council are keen to ensure these are maintained in good condition.

Whilst Norfolk County Council (NCC) are responsible for managing PROW's, they need to be kept informed of any issues that arise (via the NCC website) and work with the impacted landowners. The Parish Council believe we can all help with this by ensuring issues are promptly reported and reporting back to the parish and the NCC on progress.

In order to do this well, as a first step we are compiling details on the existing rights of way. If you would like to help with this work please contact the parish clerk, Bev Long.

## **Planning**

In order for the planning process to work effectively it is important for everyone to play their part – be that making appropriate planning applications, commenting on the impact of applications or raising any relevant concerns. This must be done in an honest and respectful way.

It has come to the Councils attention that a member of the parish received anonymous hate mail relating to an ongoing planning discussion. The Parish Council want to make it clear that this type of behaviour is unacceptable. The incident has been reported to the police.

### Highways - Norwich Western Link and A47 North Tuddenham to Easton Improvement

Work continues on both these major highways improvements and the Parish Council is following their progress, participating in liaison groups and commenting on consultation questions as appropriate. The developments are not expected to complete until 2025, however the council is concerned about the potential knock on impacts to the roads in our parish during construction and following completion.
