Power Cuts/Phone Availability

There is a concern that some people may be completely out of contact during power cuts due to land lines now being routed through broadband which is not available during power outages. Ofcom (who regulate phone services) have said that "If you are dependent on your landline phone your provider must offer you a solution to make sure you can contact the emergency services when a power cut occurs. For example, a mobile phone (if you have signal), or a battery back-up unit for your landline phone" (Ofcom website – Future of land line calls). They recommend you contact your provider to discuss options.
