Verges have been cut. Some areas have been left unmown to encourage wild flowers. There will be no extra cuts this year.

All areas of South Norfolk are a no poo zone and all dog owners are reminded of the need to ensure that they clean up after their dogs. The health risks to humans are well documented.

Annual Parish Meeting

This annual meeting was very well attended with the guest speaker for the evening Phil Courtier (Director of Planning for South Norfolk District Council). He gave a most interesting talk on planning policy and covered matters including permitted development, the Development Plan and the supporting framework and told the audience that 95% of applications are determined by officers. There was also an opportunity for a question and answer session.

The Chairman gave his report and included thanks to the many volunteers who work to keep the community clean and tidy.

County Councillor Margaret Dewsbury reported briefly on County matters including the fact that Broadband roll out was a high priority and that mobile mast sites were being sought. She also reported that £20m had been allocated for special needs children with this sum including the building of 4 new schools.

Plans are already in hand for the 2020 Annual Parish Meeting with a speaker who will talk about the "History of our Villages".
