Parish Council Precept 2022

The annual Parish Council precept was discussed at the January Parish Council meeting. Currently the council is in a solid financial position with income broadly matching required expenditure, a small amount of reserves held and no major additional expenditure foreseen or planned. As such it was agreed that the Parish Council precept that each household pays should be held at the same level as last year. Should a significant amount of money be required for a specific purchase separate fund raising would be undertaken.
