Annual Meeting

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held on 12th April at 7.30pm in Welborne Village Hall. This meeting is an informal opportunity to find out what has been happening in the Parish over the last 12 months with reports from the parish council, county and district councillors, parish organisations and other bodies. **Light refreshments will be provided.**

District & Town/Parish elections Thursday 4th May 2023

District and Parish elections are taking place in South Norfolk Council areas, including this parish, on **Thursday 4 May 2023**. Residents need to be registered to vote on the electoral register if they wish to vote at these elections. If you have recently moved or not registered, you will need to register by **Monday 17 April 2023**.

This year, all voters who vote in person or by proxy at polling stations will have to show an accepted form of photographic identification before they are given a ballot paper – details of accepted forms of photo id can be found on the Electoral commission website - www.electoralcommission.org.uk/i-am-a/voter/voter-id/accepted-forms-photo-id.

If you are interested in standing for election to the Parish Council, nominations open on **Friday 17 March 2023** and close at **4pm on Tuesday 4 April 2023**.
