### Norwich Western Link (NWL) Pre-Planning Application Public Consultation

The NWL Pre-Planning Application Public Consultation closed on 9<sup>th</sup> October. As part of that process the Parish Council raised a strong objection to the proposal to prohibit motor vehicles, except for access, on Barnham Broom Road between the Watton Road and Tuttle Lane in Wymondham.

### Support your Local Community – Volunteers needed

There are a number of opportunities currently available to get involved and help the local community. These vacancies crop up from time to time as people move out of the parish or other circumstances change. None of the roles are onerous but they all help the local community and the running of the local parish.

These are also excellent opportunities for people new to the parish to get involved in the community.

**Parish Councillor** – A Councillor is a member of the council and is normally elected for a term of four years. Councillors are elected to represent the interest of the local community as a whole and promote a harmonious local environment. Individual Councillors work together to serve the community and to help. Councillors contribute to the work of the council by suggesting ideas, engaging in constructive debate, responding to the needs and views of the community and by helping the Council to make decisions on behalf of the local community. Our parish requires seven councillors and currently we have six.

The vacancy will be filled by co-option (the council invites someone to join without the need for a public election). The next public election is due to take place in 2023.

**Litter Warden** - We currently have litter wardens covering Coston, Runhall and Welborne – details on the website. There is a vacancy for a warden in Brandon Parva.

**Newsletter Delivery** – This newsletter is delivered by a team of 14 local people across the parish. There is a vacancy for someone to deliver to 12 houses in Welborne, around Pound Lane and Hall Road.
